Note: You will receive 5 points for each category entered. These will then be totaled at the end of the year for our top 3 positions of each category receiving a plaque and a cash award.

Lyme Disease Precautions

Now that the weather has warmed, we will again face some of the dangers of Lyme disease. A few precautions:

1. Wear long-sleeved shirts.
2. Avoid wooded and high-grass areas.
3. Tuck pants into boots or socks.
4. Use insect repellents containing 33% or less DEET (on skin), and pesticides containing permethrin (on clothing).

5. Check yourself and pets frequently while outside. Check again at home.

6. If you find a tick attached to your skin, use pointed tweezers to grasp the tick as close to the skin as possible. Pull steadily and firmly until the tick lets go. Apply antiseptic. *(Never twist or squeeze the tick, and never use petroleum jelly, gasoline, or a hot match on an attached tick.)*

7. Early warning signs of Lyme Disease include: a large, circular rash at least 2 inches across, that may grow in size; flu-like symptoms, stiff neck, extreme fatigue, etc.
