A Note From Our President

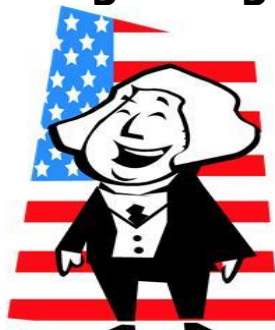
I was thinking about our club meeting on Aug. 12th. Here are a couple of things:
